

In order to ensure convenient and secure browsing of our Web service, your use of our website without changing the settings of your Web browser is understood as your approval of our use of "cookie" files. Cookie files are small text files placed within your browser's folder. When browsing a website, such file saved on the device sends certain information to the web browser. Being useful for their publishers, cookie files are very widespread, and extensively used on numerous websites. For example, they may allow the website administrator to determine if a given computer (and, likely, its user) has visited it before. Generally speaking, cookie files are used in order to improve the operation of a website and make it more user-friendly, although they may also be used for advertising purposes. Cookie files do not result in any configuration changes on the terminal device and software installed on it. The user may change the way in which the browser uses cookie files, including blocking or removing those which originate from play.pl Web pages (and from other websites). To do that, the user needs to modify browser settings.

Most browsers offer the possibility to accept or reject all cookie files, only accept certain types of cookies, or inform the user every time the website attempts to save them. The user may also easily delete cookie files which have been saved by the browser on the device.

Management and deletion of cookie files differs with the browser used. Detailed information in that regard can be obtained by using the Help function in the browser or by visiting the http://www.allaboutcookies.org website, which provides a step-by-step explanation of how to control and remove cookies in most Web browsers.
